



TLC to headline San Mateo County Fair

5 March 2018 - San Mateo, CA: Get ready for some serious “CrazySexyCool” when **TLC** takes the stage at the San Mateo County Fair in June.

Four-time Grammy award-winning **TLC** is the final band to be announced for the [San Mateo County Fair’s 2018 concert series](#). The **TLC** concert is slated for June 10 at 7:30 p.m. The concert is being presented by **Q102**, the throwback station. **All main stage concert general admission seating is free with fair admission, on an open seating, space-available basis.** For reserved seating, the fair’s **Gold Circle admission** includes fair admission plus reserved prime seating in Fiesta Hall (main stage), private entrance through Expo Café for the show, and easy access to the no-host bar and no-host food area.



The **9-day fair opens on June 9 and runs through June 17. Discount admission, carnival, and Gold Circle tickets go on sale on March 12** at [SanMateoCountyFair.com](#). Discount fair admission prices are \$10 adult; \$8 junior (ages 6-12); and \$6 seniors (ages 62+). Discount Gold Circle admission is just \$40 (all ages). Discount unlimited ride wristbands are \$28, good any day of the 9-day run.

“TLC is one of the best-selling female groups of all times,” said Dana Stoehr, CEO of the San Mateo County Event Center and Fair. “Their music is sharp, smart and sassy and they have a really unique chemistry.”

One of the greatest journeys in music history can be summed up by just three letters—TLC. Those characters merely hint at the talent of Tionne “T-Boz” Watkins, Rozonda “Chilli” Thomas, and the late Lisa “Left Eye” Lopes, but they immediately evoke an unparalleled journey nonetheless. That journey encompasses immortal anthems such as “Waterfalls,” “Creep,” “No Scrubs,” and “Unpretty,” to name a few, as well as sales of 70 million records worldwide, four GRAMMY® Awards, two RIAA diamond-certified albums among a total of four multiplatinum albums, ten Top 10 singles, and four Number 1 singles. Meanwhile, the VH1 original film *CrazySexyCool: The TLC Story* chronicled their rise and broke records as the highest-rated television film premiere of 2013 and the highest-rated original premiere on the network between consistent touring.



“We’re still TLC,” affirms Tionne. “If it’s not broke, don’t fix it. We kept the same recipe, which is strong lyrical content and talking about things that affect all of us.” “I’ve always felt a vibe between us,” says Chilli. “The chemistry has empowered us to touch so many in a positive way. Even if they don’t know us, fans think of us as their homegirls. It’s because we believe everything we say and it’s relatable.”
