2021 RV LIVESTOCK PARKING

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. All RVs must be parked only in the RV parking space to which they are assigned. If a space cannot accommodate a vehicle due to size restrictions (spaces allow for a 32' maximum length & 13' maximum width), Event Management must be notified and they will reassign the RV to a new space, if possible. You are **ALLOWED ONE VEHICLE ONLY**.
2. A designated Event Center employee must be present when you place your RV into your assigned space to ensure that it is correctly placed. If you park your RV on your own and you are parked in the wrong space, you will be required to move your RV to its correct space. There will be an Event Center employee available to place RVs during the Exhibitor move-in dates.
3. All Federal, State and Local Laws apply. A parent or legal guardian must be in the RV with an exhibitor at all times, and must be present when youths are staying overnight in the livestock area.
4. **NO ALCOHOL!** Individuals may not bring alcoholic beverages onto the San Mateo County Event Center grounds, including the parking lot areas. Any alcohol brought onto the fairgrounds from a RV will lead to immediate removal of the offender. Any alcohol consumed or brought onto the fairgrounds by the exhibitor, parent, guardian, family member or guests, will lead to immediate removal of the exhibitor **AND** their animal(s).
5. All tow vehicles must be parked in a designated parking space with the parking pass.
6. Any and all problems or situations that arise pertaining to RV parking should be brought to the attention of the Parking Department. The Parking Department, in conjunction with the Fair Department, will have the final authority pertaining to all RV parking issues.
7. To meet Fire Marshal regulations, at no time may an extension cord be stretched across a road or fire lane to supply electricity to other RVs or stock trucks. If cords are found stretched Event Management will unplug them and an attempt will be made to notify the owner of the vehicle to which the extension cord was connected. If this vehicle is found to be plugged in a second time, Event Management reserves the right to confiscate the extension cord and/or require the owner to remove their RV or stock truck from the grounds. No exceptions will be made to this rule.
8. Fair Management reserves the right to remove any RV from the San Mateo County Event Center grounds if the vehicle's owner or occupants are found to be in violation of these terms and conditions. Disciplinary action will be up to the discretion of the Livestock Coordinator and/or fair management and may result in the removal of animals and/or exhibitors from the remaining fair and/or future fairs.
9. Permittee, for the life of this Agreement, will maintain and/or leave the facilities used hereunder in the same condition as when it accepts same for use, reasonable wear and tear excepted, and will be responsible for any damage occurring thereto by reason of the holding of, or conduct of said activity. Permittee further agrees to hold the San Mateo County Exposition and Fair Association harmless from any liability for personal injury, property damages or other liability arising out of, or in connection with, the conduct of said activity, and shall furnish the Association at the time of the execution hereof with certificate from a reputable insurance carrier that it has insurance covering such damages during the life of this Agreement, which policies shall insure the San Mateo Exposition and Fair Association against any liability which may arise in connection with the holding of said activity.

2021 FAIR LIVESTOCK SAFETY PLAN

- All exhibitors, their family members and other related persons participating in the livestock events shall sign the release and waiver of liability agreement before entering any livestock event.
- All clubs are expected to have their exhibitors, family members and other related people participating in the livestock events fill out the Exposure Control Plan (health questionnaire) daily before entry through Gate 9 and given to security. If security or anyone receiving the questionnaire sees an exhibitor state “Y” (YES), the Livestock Office, Fair Manager or CEO will be contacted immediately.
- Each exhibitor, their family members and other related persons participating in the livestock events will receive a temperature check by security at the Livestock Gate (Gate 9) before entry. Any person presenting a body temperature above 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit will not be permitted to participate in the livestock events or receive access to the fair.
- All exhibitors, their family members and other related persons participating in the livestock events shall comply with all health and safety orders, rules and guidelines related to the Virus promulgated by the State of California, County of San Mateo, City of San Mateo and the San Mateo County Fair.
- Without limiting the foregoing, Exhibitor, their family members and other related persons participating in the livestock events agree that they will wear a face mask at all times including exhibiting, wash hands frequently, use hand sanitizer or antibacterial wipes, maintain social distancing, and submit to non-invasive body temperature measurement.
- Inside the arena during shows, only persons within the same household will be able to sit with each other. Occupants of different households must sit 6 feet apart.
- All folding chairs set on the show ring during the Livestock Auction and Youth Awards will be separated by 6’.
- Exhibitors and their family members acknowledge that personal protective equipment (“PPE”) designed to reduce the chances of exposure to or infection with the Virus may not be readily available at the fair’s facilities for their participation in the livestock events. Exhibitors and their family members acknowledge that the San Mateo County Fair may not, and is under no legal duty to, provide any PPE to Exhibitors or their family members. Exhibitors and their families should provide their own PPE for participation in the San Mateo County Fair’s livestock events.
- Exhibitors and their family members understand and acknowledge that participation in the Fair’s livestock events or use of Fair’s facilities may expose them to contact with one or more persons who have been infected with, and/or exposed to, the Virus. Exhibitors and their family members further understand that participation in the Fair livestock events or use of the facilities may expose them to contact with surfaces or objects that contain the Virus and may serve as a means for transmission of the Virus to others who participate in the livestock events or use the facilities. Based on the foregoing, Exhibitors and their family members understand and acknowledge that participation in the State Fair livestock events and use of the facilities may expose them, along with others with whom they may come in contact after they leave Fair’s facilities, to a risk of infection with the Virus, which may cause significant and serious illness, bodily injury, disfigurement, temporary or permanent disability, and/or death.
